NOW TO THE HANDWRITING!

*“Mene, Mene, Tekel, Upharsin”* (5:25). These three words reveal three ELEMENTS involved in the sinner’s destruction:

- \_\_\_\_\_—That meant that the king’s days were numbered.
  
- \_\_\_\_\_—That meant that king was found wanting, that is lacking no repentance.
  
- \_\_\_\_\_—That meant that the king was divided, separated from the saved and condemned to hell.
