

**Amazed at the Power of His Word**  
**Luke 4:31-37**

**Context:** Look at the words, “Astonished” and “amazed.” These words mean to be struck.

**NOTICE THEY WERE AMAZED AT THE:**

**I. Power in His \_\_\_\_\_ (vs. 31-32)**

We should always be amazed at God’s Word. God’s Word is an immovable Anchor in times of severe storm.

*John 6:63 It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: the words that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and they are life.*

*I Corinthians 2:4 And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power*

**II. Power over the \_\_\_\_\_ Domain (vs. 33-36)**

If Jesus is the head of all principality and power, then it follows that He has power over the spiritual domain.

*I Peter 3:22 Who is gone into heaven and is on the right hand of God; angels and authorities and powers being made subject unto him.*

*Matthew 28:18 And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth.*

**III. Result: \_\_\_\_\_ Spread Abroad (vs. 37)**

Fame – *echos* = kept going forth.

What amazes us will be what we talk about to others. When we are still amazed by God’s grace, it will be the subject of much of our conversation. It will consume our life and fill us with joy.
