A. Question #1—Who makes salvation _____? (Jonah 2:9; Romans 3:30; 8:33).

B. Question #2—How does salvation _____, by works or faith? (Ephesians 2:8-10; Roman 4:5; Titus 3:5).

C. Question #3—How is salvation _____, by man or God? (Psalm 37:8; Jude 24; 1 Peter 1:5).

CONCLUSION: The method by which God saves man is OF GOD from BEGINNING to END! It is therefore ETERNAL and UNCHANGEABLE!
