In the text, we discover two things:

- The \_\_\_\_\_ of the unsaved—believing and calling.
- The \_\_\_\_\_ of the saved—speaking and sending

**I. FIRST, NOTICE THE \_\_\_\_\_—THE BELIEVER’S FEET (Romans 10:15b).** *“ . . . as it is written, How beautiful are the feet of them that preach the gospel and bring glad tidings of good things.”*

**II. SECONDLY, CONSIDER THE \_\_\_\_\_ OF GOD--THE BELIEVER’S BURDENED HEART.** (Romans 10:16). *But they have not all obeyed the gospel. For Esaias saith, Lord, who hath believed our report?”*

The reward of the messenger is actually two-fold:

- First, the reward of a \_\_\_\_\_ blessing, and . . .
- Secondly, the regret of a \_\_\_\_\_ burden.

**III. THIRDLY, NOTE THE \_\_\_\_\_ OF GOD—THE BELIEVER’S DISTINCTIVE SMELL (Romans 10:17).** *“So then faith cometh by hearing and hearing by the word of God.”*

**CONCLUSION: The most compelling evidence that Christ is alive and triumphant is the LIFE OF A SOLD OUT CHILD OF GOD!**
