*“How do you Spot a Changed Life?”*

2 Corinthians 5:17; Selected Passages

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**I. FIRST, THAT CHANGE INVOLVES A NEW \_\_\_\_\_—A Change in Ownership (Ephesians 2:12-13).**

**II. SECONDLY, THAT CHANGE INCLUDES A NEW \_\_\_\_\_—A Change in Relationship (Ephesians 2:12-13; Romans 5:1).**

**III. THIRDLY, THAT CHANGE INTRODUCES A NEW \_\_\_\_\_—A Change in Direction (Ephesians 2:2; John 3:2-5).**

**IV. FOURTHLY, THAT CHANGE INCORPORATES A NEW \_\_\_\_\_—A Change in Desire (Ephesians 2:1-3).**

**V. FIFTHLY, THAT CHANGE INJECTS A NEW \_\_\_\_\_—A Change in Disposition (1 Corinthians 6:9-11).**

This process is described in the Bible in THREE TENSES:

A. First, it involves the \_\_\_\_\_ (1 Corinthians 1:2). *“I have been sanctified, because I have been saved from the PENALTY of sin.”*

B. Secondly, it includes the \_\_\_\_\_ (2 Corinthians 3:18). *“I am being sanctified, because I have POWER over sin.”*

C. Thirdly, it instills a new \_\_\_\_\_ (Romans 8:30). *“I will one day be delivered from the very PRESENCE of sin.”*
