DEFINITION OF WALKING WITH GOD: God is your first priority. He is at the center of your thinking, in every relationship, decision, and daily task.

What does it mean to walk with God?

Amos 3:3 implies by question that two people cannot walk together unless they agree. One or both will decide to go their own way when in disagreement.

I John 1:5-7 tells us that God is light and if we walk in darkness, we are not walking with Him. Light and darkness do not fellowship because they are diametrically opposed.
