

## WHAT HAPPENS WHEN JESUS SHOWS UP

John 20:19-23

Before going into the body of messages, look at 3 simple rules:

- RULE #1—Jesus shows up when things seem \_\_\_\_\_.
- RULE #2—Jesus shows because He understand the struggles we are \_\_\_\_\_.
- RULE #3—Jesus shows up because he cares \_\_\_\_\_.

The disciples in this passage were facing several different emotions:

Now let's move through this passage and see WHAT HAPPENS WHEN JESUS COMES IN:

**I. FIRST, WHEN JESUS COMES IN, HE MAKES LIFE \_\_\_\_\_ (John 20:19b). “... *Peace be unto you.*”**

**II. SECONDLY, WHEN JESUS COMES IN, HE MAKES LIFE \_\_\_\_\_ (John 20:20) “... *then were the disciples glad...*”**

Jesus used the phrase “*Be of good cheer,*” several times:

A. He spoke of forgiveness for the \_\_\_\_\_ (Matthew 9:2).

B. He spoke of companionship for our \_\_\_\_\_ (Matthew 14:27).

C. He spoke of victory for our \_\_\_\_\_ (John 16:33)

**III. THIRDLY, WHEN JESUS COMES IN HE MAKES US \_\_\_\_\_ (John 20:21). “*Then Jesus saith unto them again, Peace be unto you: as my Father hath sent me, even so send I you.*”**

We are to be:

A. A \_\_\_\_\_ to speak for Jesus (in this world).

B. We are to be \_\_\_\_\_ to brings us faithfully to church wherever the doors are open.

C. We are to be \_\_\_\_\_ to help out in the many opportunities our church has to reach out into this community.

D. We are to be \_\_\_\_\_ to see a lost world without Christ and give so that others may go.

**IV. FOURTHLY, WHEN JESUS COMES IN, HE MAKES OUR LIVES \_\_\_\_\_ (John 20:22).**
