I. FIRST, NOTICE HOW <u>CREATION</u> SUFFERS (Romans 8:18-22).

A. First, creation is cursed by the *past* (8:20).

Note some things that happened because of man's sin:

- 1. First, man's sin is responsible for all natural *disease*.
- 2. Secondly, man's sin is responsible for all natural *disasters*.
- 3. Thirdly, man's sin is responsible for all natural decay.
- B. Secondly, the curse will be reversed in the *future* (8:21).
- C. Thirdly, creation is "groaning" in the present (8:22).
