- A. First, His power to secure us is declared by His *interest* in us (8:31b). “*If God be for us, who can be against us.*”
- B. Secondly, His power to secure us is demonstrated by his *investment* in us (8:32a).

- C. Thirdly, His power to secure us is displayed in His *intentions* for us (8:32b).
- D. Fourthly His power to secure us in is declared in His *insistence* concerning us (8:33).
