How Does God Save the Ungodly?—Romans 3:19—8:39 He Saves Them Forever ... BECAUSE"

Romans 8:31-39

Introduction:

I. FIRST, NOTICE HOW WE ARE SECURE THROUGH THE <u>POWER</u> OF JESUS (Romans 8:31-33).

- A. First, His power to secure us is declared by His <u>interest</u> in us (8:31b). "If God be for us, who can be against us."
- B. Secondly, His power to secure us is demonstrated by his *investment* in us (8:32a).

CONCLUSION #1—Because God had <u>*delivered*</u> you; there isn't anyone who can <u>*destroy*</u> you!

- C. Thirdly, His power to secure us is displayed in His *intentions* for us (8:32b).
- D. Fourthly His power to secure us in is declared in His *insistence* concerning us (8:33).

CONCLUSION #2—Because God has <u>*acquitted*</u> you; there isn't anyone that can <u>*indict*</u> you!

II. SECONDLY, NOTE HOW WE ARE SECURE THROUGH THE <u>PERSON</u> OF CHRIST (Romans 8:24).

- A. First, note the *price* that He discharged on the cross.
- B. Secondly, consider the *power* He displayed at the tomb.
- C. Thirdly, notice the *position* He dominates at the throne.

CONCLUSION #3—Because Jesus Christ *redeemed* you; there isn't anyone who can <u>condemn</u> you!

- III. THIRDLY, CONSIDER HOW WE ARE SECURE THROUGH THE OF CHRIST (Romans 8:35-29).
- A. First, His passion for us is _____ (8:35-36).
