Please note the challenges Paul revealed in considering the thought: “*Committed to Finishing Well*”:

- I. **FIRST NOTE HOW WE ARE CHALLENGED TO \_\_\_\_\_ THE TRUTH (Philippians 3:13a)** “*Brethren, I count not myself to have apprehended . . .*”
  
- II. **SECONDLY, NOTICE HOW WE ARE CONFRONTED TO \_\_\_\_\_ THE PAST (Philippians 3:13b)** “*. . . but this one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind . . .*”
  - A. We must overcome the desire to \_\_\_\_\_ on past accomplishments.

  - C. We must overcome the desire to \_\_\_\_\_ on past failures.

III. **THIRDLY, CONSIDER THE CHARGE TO \_\_\_\_\_ THE ZEAL THAT MAY HAVE BEEN LOST (Philippians 3:13c)** “*. . . and reaching forth unto those things which are before.*”

IV. **FOURTHLY, WE THEN ARE CONTESTED TO \_\_\_\_\_ THE RACE (Philippians 3:14).** “*I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus.*”
