Revelation 20:11-15

Introduction. _____

To better understand this final judgment at the end times, the courtroom scene is broken down into four headings with several points under these:

I. FIRST, NOTICE HOW THE SETTING IS DESCRIBED (Revelation 20:11) “*And I saw . . . them.*”

A. First, notice the actual place (20:11a) “*And I saw a great white throne . . .*”

B. Secondly, note the Awesome Person (20:11) “*And I saw . . . him that sat on it . . .*”

C. Thirdly, consider the awkward position (20:11) “. . . *from whose face the heaven and earth fled away and there was found no place for them.*”

II. SECONDLY, NOTE HOW THE SUMMONS IS DELIVERED (Revelation 20:12-13).
