**(Just how will be judged?) (Selected Passages).**

- A. First, we will be judged individually (Romans 10:12; 2 Corinthians 5:10).
  
- B. Secondly, we will be judged impartially (Selected Passages).
  
- C. Thirdly, we will be judged inclusively (Romans 14:10).
  
- VI. **SIXTHLY, BE AWARE OF THE PURPOSE OF THE JUDGMENT SEAT (Just why do we have to be judged?).**
  - A. First, the purpose for the Judgment Seat will be to determine what we will gain (1 Corinthians 3:14).
    - 1. First, the Bible teaches that God has always reserved special rewards for those who are the most faithful.
    - 2. Secondly, the Bible teaches that as the Bride of Christ, the gown will be made of “. . . *the righteousness* (righteous acts) *of the saints.*”
  
  - B. Secondly, the purpose for the Judgment Seat will be to determine what we will lose (1 Corinthians 3:15).

3.

1. First, notice rewards will be lost by default (Revelation 3:11).
2. Secondly, note how rewards will be lost by defect (1 Corinthians 3:10, 15).
3. Thirdly, consider how some rewards can be lost by disqualification (1 Corinthians 9:24-27).
  - a. First, idolatry was considered disqualifying (1 Corinthians 10:6-7).
  - b. Secondly, sexual immorality was considered disqualifying (1 Corinthian 10:8).
  - c. Thirdly, trying or questioning the Lord's leading was considered disqualifying (1 Corinthians 10:9).
  - d. Fourthly, grumbling was considered to be disqualifying (1 Corinthians 10:10).
