Jesus as a LION in the Midst of JUDGMENT

“When The LION Makes Another PAUSE”

Revelation 10:1-11

Introduction. _____

I. FIRST, NOTE THE VISION JOHN SAW (Revelation 10:1-3).

- A. First, John sees his glorious *clothing*, an emblem of God’s coming judgment (10:1b).
- B. Secondly, John sees his glittering *crown* depicting his honor of God’s covenant (10:1c).
- C. Thirdly, he sees his gratifying *countenance*, reflecting the glory of God, like that of Moses as he descended down from the mountain (10:1d).
- D. Fourthly, he sees his grand *conquest*, revealing God’s awesome power and might (10:1e).
- E. Finally, John sees his grandiose *composition* recording God’s promises (10:2).

II. SECONDLY, NOTICE THE VOICES JOHN HEARD (Revelation 10:3-7).

- A. First, notice there were voices of *exclusion* (10:3-4).

B. Secondly, there were voices of *exposure* (10:5-7).

- 1. First, his voice of exposure is *sure* (10:5).
- 2. Secondly, his voice of exposure is *solemn* (10:6).
- 3. Thirdly, his voice of exposure is *significant* (10:7).

III. THIRDLY, CONSIDER THE _____ HE _____ (Revelation 10:8-11).

- A. First, the truth of God’s Word must be personally _____ (10:9-10).
- B. Secondly, the truth of God’s Word must be publicly _____ (10:11).
