Introduction. _____

I. FIRST, NOTICE HOW ONE OF THE VITAL SIGNS OF LIFE IS THE CHANGED WALK (1 John 5:1-5).

- A. First, this changed walk involves a personal relationship (5:1).
- B. Secondly, this changed walk includes a profound rearrangement (5:2-5).
1. First, there will be a dedication to love the saints (5:1b-2a).

- d. Fourthly, the witness of the Spirit is supreme.
- e. Fifthly, the witness of the Spirit is Christ-centered (John 16:13-14).
