

## THE CHOICE TO REJOICE

Habakkuk 3:16-19

It is here that Habakkuk share three affirmations of his faith that all who know the Lord can say:

### I. FIRST, HE SAYS THAT WE TO \_\_\_\_\_ IN THE LORD (Habakkuk 3:16).

In Matthew 11:18-30, our Lord invites us to that place of SPIRITUAL REST. Notice His invitation:

- A. First, He calls us to rest in \_\_\_\_\_

- C. Thirdly, He challenges us to \_\_\_\_\_ (11:29b-30) “*. . . and learn of me: for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. For my yoke is easy and my burden is light.*”

### II. SECONDLY, HE SAYS THAT WE ARE TO \_\_\_\_\_ IN THE LORD (Habakkuk 3:17a-18) “*Although . . . Yet I will rejoice in the LORD I will joy the God of my salvation.*”

### III. THEN, THIRDLY, HE SAYS THAT WE ARE TO \_\_\_\_\_ ON THE LORD (Habakkuk 3:19).
