Revelation 21:1-8

Introduction: _____

Three heavens:

1. **First, there is the Telestial or Atmospheric Heaven—(Genesis 6:7; Isaiah 55:9-11; James 5:18). This is the home of the SPARROWS!**
2. **Second, there is the Celestial heaven (Deuteronomy 4:19; Matthew 24:29). This is the home of the STARS!**
3. **Thirdly, there is the Sanctified Heaven—The Third Heaven—The Abode of God (Acts 1:8-11; 2 Corinthians 12:2). This is the home of the SAINTS!**

Now look at the first 8 verses of this chapter:

I. FIRST, NOTICE A BRAND NEW CREATION (Revelation 21:1).

- A. First, note how it will be rarely distinctive (21:1a).

1. First, we see a world in the past, and it perished (2 Peter 3:6).
2. Then we see a world at present and how it will be purged (2 Peter 3:7).
3. And, we see a world that is prophetic, a world that is promised (2 Peter 3:14).

B. Secondly, see how this present world will radically disappear (21:1b). “. . . *pass away.*”

C. Thirdly, note how the brand new world will be radiantly different (21:1c).

II. SECONDLY, NOTE HOW WE WILL HAVE A BRIGHT NEW CAPITAL (Revelation 21:2).

A. First, it is described as blameless (21:2a).

B. Secondly, it is displayed as brilliant (21:2c).

III. THIRDLY, CONSIDER HOW WE HAVE A BLESSED NEW COMMUNITY (21:3-4).

A. First, notice heaven’s primary relationship, the presence of God (21:3).

1. First, His presence will produce the greatest miracle of this new universe.
